Start authorization:	Only active players with a player pass who belong to a club that is a member of one of the national associations affiliated with the IFI.
Admission:	Per national association: Team competition: 1 team from the U16, U19 and U23 youth categories Target competition: 4 individual competitors Team goal competition: 1 team from the U16, U19 and U23 youth teams (male/female) Mixed competition: 1 mixed team U23 juniors (2 boys and girls)



Registration deadline:	All registrations must be received by 22 December 2025 at the latest at the IFI (International Federation Icestocksport) office, Otto-Fleck-Schneise 12, D-60528 Frankfurt am Main, E-Mail: office@icestock.sport and alois.bosl@icestock.sport . Entries must contain precise information about the competitions in which the national associations will participate and the number of starters in each class. The enclosed form with the names of all delegation members must be completed and returned by 31 January 2026 .

Referees:	Referees are appointed by the IFI
Sports equipment - Test protocol:	All sports equipment for the European Championships must be inspected in advance by an A-level referee with an IFI protocol (01.10.25). The inspection of sports equipment is based on the DfB-18.02.2025 for IFI competitions (1.7.1 to 1.7.4) . Competition directors and referees shall inspect the sport equipment before, during and after the competition. Any necessary disciplinary measures shall be taken in accordance with the IER, IspO and VGO of the IFI. General equipment inspection in accordance with the schedule.
Material provision:	This is carried out in accordance with the DfB-18.02.2025 for the IFI competitions (2.2.1 to 2.2.5). The <u>request for the winter soles</u> must be made to the IFI <u>at the time of registration</u> . The requested winter soles must be returned in perfect condition and cleaned. They must not be permanently labelled or marked. All players may only play with the skittles allocated to the individual lanes in team games. These weigh between 3,700 g and 3,730 g (IFI type L) and remain on the lanes. Players may use their own skittles for target competitions if these have been tested and approved for this purpose by the IFI testing commission. These will be provided if required.
Special provision:	<u>Team game and target competition:</u> (all game classes) A phase-out period of 4 years applies to the WLS types IFI No. 26.1 (light blue) to IFI No. 25.3 (broom yellow) inclusive that are used and requested, i.e. WLS with the current + previous JKB are valid.

Special provision:	In team competitions for U16, U19 and U23 juniors, if up to five nations (= five teams) are participating, a double round or VR + RR will be played, followed by final matches in a page play-off system (only one match each) for all classes on the cross lanes. If there are 6 or more participating nations (= 6 teams), the second round must be omitted.
Award ceremony:	The winners will be honoured in accordance with ISpO § 422 and IFI implementation regulations.
Anti-doping:	Doping controls may be carried out to ensure compliance with IFI doping regulations.
