Schedule:	Please refer to the appendix starting on page 4 for the preliminary schedule. The final schedule will be drawn up and published after the entries have been submitted. Any changes that may then be necessary will be announced at the competition office on site.
Competitions:	Distance competitions for women and men, youth U16, U19 and juniors U23 In individual competition, team classification and mixed team.
Rating:	According to the International Icestock Rules (IER) 2022 and the International Playing Rules (ISpO) 2022 in conjunction with the IFI Implementation Regulations of 18 February 2025 of the IFI.
Start authorization:	Only active players with a player pass who belong to a club that is a member of one of the national associations affiliated with the IFI.
Admission:	Four participants per nation, women, men, youth U16, U19 and juniors U23 (If divided into groups, the number of starters will be adjusted) Two mixed teams may be registered per nation.



Registration deadline:	All registrations must be received by 22 December 2025 at the latest at the IFI (International Federation Icestocksport) office, Otto-Fleck-Schneise 12, D-60528 Frankfurt am Main, E-Mail: office@icestock.sport and alois.bosl@icestock.sport . Entries must contain precise information about the competitions in which the national associations will participate and the number of starters in each class. The enclosed form with the names of all delegation members must be completed and returned by 31 January 2026 .
Entry fee:	CHF 20.00 = 20.00 € per starter in the distance competition. All entry fees must be paid in cash when submitting player passes at the competition office on site during registration.

Sports equipment check:	Each piece of sports equipment must be checked by a qualified referee. A separate/individual inspection report is not necessary. A maximum of 3 sticks per player may be submitted for sports equipment inspection. These will then be randomly checked on site and subsequently registered in full and without exception. A corresponding sticker for admission to the competitions will be affixed by the inspection referee. If a stick does not meet the inspection criteria, it will be confiscated. A maximum of 1 stick per starter may be submitted at a later date.
Stock body:	The IFI provides the stock bodies.
Outsoles:	The outsoles are provided by IFI.
Sticks:	Players must provide their own IFI-approved sticks.
Award ceremony:	The winners will be honoured in accordance with ISpO § 422 and IFI implementation regulations.
Anti-Doping:	The winners will be honoured in accordance with ISpO § 422 and IFI implementation regulations.
