<b>Schedule:</b>	Please refer to the appendix on page 3 for the preliminary schedule.  The final schedule will be drawn up and published after registration. Any changes that may then be necessary will be announced at the competition office on site.
<b>Admission:</b>	Up to 4 teams per national association. If the number of participants exceeds 24 teams, this will be reduced to 3 teams per national association. The host nation will receive one additional starting place in the Women's European Cup for club teams, which will be given to the host club/association. Except for AUT, GER, and ITA, national associations are permitted to register players from two clubs, with at least two players coming from each club.
<b>Starting authorisation:</b>	Only active players with a player pass who belong to a club that is a member of one of the national associations affiliated with the IFI.
<b>Title award:</b>	The winning team will receive the title:  <b>"EUROPEAN CUP Winner in the Women's Team Competition 2025."</b>
<b>Rating:</b>	According to the International Icestock Rules (IER) 2022 and the International Game Rules (ISpO) 2022 in conjunction with the IFI Implementation Regulations of <b>February 18, 2025</b> , issued by the IFI (informative excerpt enclosed).
<b>Additional provision:</b>	Teams must use 4 sticks from the same manufacturer. If a team is unable to meet these requirements, it may apply to the IFI to borrow sticks.



<b>Registration deadline:</b>	All registrations must be received by the IFI (International Federation Icestocksport) office, Otto-Fleck-Schneise 12, D-60528 Frankfurt am Main, Germany, by <b>October 25, 2025</b> , at the latest. Entries must include the <b>name of the club and the address, including the email address, of the team.</b>

<b>Award ceremony:</b>	The winners will be honoured in accordance with ISpO § 422 and IFI implementation regulations.
<b>Anti-Doping:</b>	Doping controls may be carried out to ensure compliance with IFI doping regulations.
