



TENDER to the 11th AFRIKA-Cup for Women and Men Team Game and Target Competition Friday 19 June to Sunday 21 June 2026 in Windhoek / Namibia

Venue:	German Gymnastics and Sport Club Windhoek / Namibia Sean McBride & Tennis Street, Olympia, Windhoek / Namibia
Play surface/Advice:	Play will be conducted on concrete flooring. The team game is to be done in uniform playing clothes (outerwear) of the teams.
Date:	Friday 19 June to Sunday 21 June 2026
Time schedule:	Please see the provisional schedule on page 3. The exact schedule will be created after the registration deadline and after the exact number of participants is known and will be communicated to the nations immediately. The overall management reserves the right to make changes at short notice if necessary.
Competitions:	Target competition Women, Men and Youth Team game Women and Men
Starting eligibility:	Are only active players with a player's pass who belong to a club that is registered with one of the IFI affiliated national associations based in Africa.
Playing permit:	One team per national association; in addition, up to four individual starters in the target competition. If 2 nations (= 2 teams) participate, the cup winner will be determined in a 9-round team competition; if 3 nations participate, in a 3-round competition; and if 4 teams participate, in a 3-round competition. In the target competition, a double round will be held.
Closing of Entries:	All entries must be sent to the IFI office no later than April 18, 2026, 12:00 CEST (participants' names must be reported). International Federation Icestocksport, Probst-Gerhoh-Str. 6, D-82398 Polling, email: alois.bosl@icestock.sport with a copy to office@icestock.sport . The entries must contain precise details of the competitions and the number of starters in the individual classes in which the national associations are obliged to participate.



Rating:	International Ice Stock Rules (IER) and International Game Rules (ISpO).
Entry fees:	Per team in the team game 20,00 CHF. Per starter in the target competition 5,00 CHF. All entry fees must be paid in cash when handing in the player's passports at the competition office on site.
